Contract Title: Procurement of Laboratory equipment for improvement of water quality control

Reference No. (as per Procurement Plan): UIP2-CHS-ICB-05

1. This invitation for bids follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in UN Development Business issue of August 5, 2014.

2. Ukraine has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Second Urban Infrastructure Project (UIP2), and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for “Procurement of Laboratory equipment for improvement of water quality control” (one contract No. UIP2-CHS-ICB-05).

3. Communal Enterprise “Cherkasyvodokanal” of Cherkasy City Council now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for procurement of the following goods and related services:

- HPLC-system with fluorescence detector for polyaromatic components determination – 1 set;
- HPLC-system with conductivity detector for anions determination – 1 set;
- TOC-analyzer for determination total organic carbon, total inorganic carbon and total nitrogen – 1 set;
- Flame and furnace atomic absorption spectrophotometer – 1 set;
- Related Services: goods’ commissioning services in purchaser’s premises and training of purchaser’s personnel.

More detailed description of the goods and related services is given in the bidding documents.

Goods and related services must be delivered to Communal Enterprise “Cherkasyvodokanal”: 12, H. Sahaidachnogo Street, Cherkasy, 18036, Ukraine.

Good delivery schedule: earliest 30 calendar days after contract signing, latest 90 calendar days after contract signing.

Related Service delivery schedule: 15 calendar days after delivery of goods.

Margin of domestic preference is not applied.

Qualification requirements for bidders are:

(a) If Bidder is Manufacturer:

(i) Financial Capability

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s): The Bidder should demonstrate certified financial statements for each of the two past years showing a turnover greater or equal to USD 0,5 million. Local Bidders shall also submit documentary evidence of not having deferred debts to Tax authorities.

(ii) Experience and Technical Capacity

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence to demonstrate that it meets the following experience requirement(s):

- a) The Bidder shall have at least three (3) years of experience in manufacture of similar goods. Appropriate documents must be submitted to confirm this requirement;
- b) The Bidder shall have at least two (2) successfully completed contracts for supply of similar goods during the last two (2) years each in amount not less than US\$ 200 000 (two hundred thousand US dollars).

(b) If Bidder is not Manufacturer:

- (i) If a Bidder is not a manufacturer, it must give permission from the Manufacturer under Manufacturer's Authorization Form (included in the Bidding Document), the Manufacturer shall demonstrate the above qualifications (i), (ii) a), and the Bidder shall demonstrate that it has successfully completed at least two (2) contracts for supply of similar goods during the last two (2) years each in amount not less than US\$ 200 000 (two hundred thousand US dollars).
- (ii) The Bidder should demonstrate certified financial statements for each of the two past years showing a turnover greater or equal to USD 0,5 million. Local Bidders should submit also documentary evidence of not having deferred debts to Tax authorities.

4. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, dated January 2011 as revised through July 2014 Corrigenda ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

5. A complete set of bidding documents in English language may be purchased by interested eligible bidders upon the submission of a written application to the Address (1) below and payment of a non-refundable fee of UAH 5100,00 (five thousand one hundred Ukrainian Hryvnia) or USD 210,00 (two hundred ten US dollars). The method of payment will be bank transfer to the bank accounts indicated below. The document will be sent by airmail for overseas delivery and surface mail or courier for local inland delivery or can be picked from the Address (1) below.

7. The provisions in the Instructions to Bidders and in the General Conditions of Contract are the provisions of the World Bank Standard Bidding Document for Procurement of Goods, April 2015.

8. Bids must be delivered to Address (1) below before 14:00 local time November 12, 2019. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the Address (2) below at 14:00 local time November 12, 2019.

9. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid-Securing Declaration as per format given in the bidding documents.
